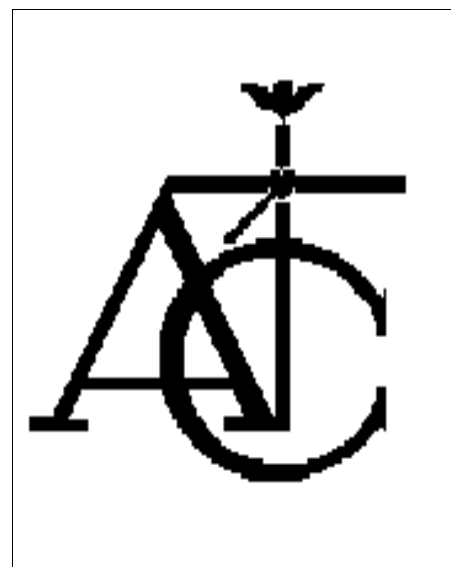
BAKE SALE!

Local Assembly

The Assembly for the Houston Center will be held on Saturday, May 4th. We are very fortunate that Fr. Celso Marquez, M.Sp.S. will join us in our Assembly this year.

The Assembly will begin with Mass at St. Thomas More Church, at 9:00 a.m. At Mass several people will receive their crosses. This portion of the Assembly will be open to everyone.

The “business” portion of the Assembly will begin after Mass and will be held at Printer Hall. Only members of the Apostleship of the Cross may attend this portion of the Assembly. We are requesting a \$10 registration fee, which will cover the cost of lunch.

This Assembly is very important for the Houston Center. We will elect our Coordinator and Council Members for the coming two-year period, and we will also plan our goals for the same period. In addition, at the Assembly we will discuss a restructuring of the Houston Center, which has been approved by Fr. Bill Young and the Council.

Under this restructuring, the Houston Center will now have three sections, one section each from Notre Dame, St. Theresa and St. Thomas More Parishes. Each section will elect one Section Coordinator, who will also serve as a Council Member. The Section Coordinators, along with the Coordinator of the Houston Center, will serve two-year terms on the Council. To assist each Section Coordinator with his or her responsibilities for their Sections, each Section will also elect two Committee Members to assist the Section Coordinator.

Thus, at the Assembly the entire Houston Center will first elect a Coordinator for the Houston Center, who will serve a two-year term. Next, the Sections from St. Theresa and from St. Thomas More will elect their respective Section Coordinators, who will serve with the Center Coordinator as Council Members. Finally, the St. Theresa and St. Thomas More Sections will each elect two Committee Members to assist their respective Section Coordinators. The election of the Committee Members, however, will not take place at the Assembly but will take place at a later date, to be determined by the Sections. Also, due to a scheduling conflict, many members of the Notre Dame section will not be able to attend, so that section will elect its Section Coordinator and Committee Members at a later date.

Please note that both integral and fundamental members of the Apostleship of the Cross may attend the Assembly. Due to the important issues that will be addressed, we strongly encourage all to attend, and we look forward to seeing everyone there.
